



SofiLingo is an iPhone app that translates what's in front of you when you travel: menus, street signs, timetables and labels. It is built for being abroad without a data plan. Typed translation works offline in all 58 languages, and the app says plainly which languages the camera can read without a signal and which it can't. It needs no account, and is made in Ireland by www.caddora.ie.

Account	None. No sign-up, no email address.
Price	First 15 translations free, with ads. Holiday pass \$4.99 for 14 days, one payment, does not renew. Monthly \$5.99 with a 3-day free trial for eligible new subscribers. Yearly \$49.99. Any pass removes ads. The App Store charges in local currency.

What's different

- **Honest about offline.** A published, language-by-language list of what works without signal, generated from the app's own code: sofilingo.com/languages
- **Nothing captured is lost.** A scan made without signal is kept and translated the moment the phone is back online.
- **No account, and a pass that doesn't renew.** The 14-day Holiday pass is a single payment built for one trip.

Privacy

Typed text and translations never leave the phone. Photos are sent for text recognition only in the languages the phone can't read well, and only when there's a connection. No analytics. The free tier carries ads; any pass removes them. Full policy: sofilingo.com/privacy
